Robert "Skip" Harrison

On August 10, 2007, Robert Lamont Skip Harrison, Jr., pled guilty to 3 counts of failing to file his tax returns in 2004, 2005 and 2006. Judge Paul Hacker of the Anne Arundel County Circuit Court sentenced Mr. Harrison to 1 year of jail, suspended, with 4 years of probation. During the period of probation, Mr. Harrison must perform 200 hours of community service, and pay a \$5,000 fine. Mr. Harrison must also file all outstanding tax returns, and pay any late fees, fines, or taxes owed.

On the same date, the Court placed the charges of Theft and Conspiracy to Violate Election Laws on the Stet docket. As special conditions of these charges being on the Stet docket, the Court imposed the following special conditions:

- 1) Mr. Harrison must pay \$505.00 to the Committee to Elect Hattie Harrison;
- 2) Mr. Harrison may not participate in any way with any political campaign finance activity, including but not limited to the following:
 - a. Mr. Harrison may not be a campaign treasurer, chairperson, sub-treasurer, or any other campaign finance committee "officer" as defined in the Election Article, Annotated Code of Maryland;
 - b. Mr. Harrison may not handle money in any capacity, as treasurer in law or as de facto treasurer, for any campaign finance committee;
 - c. Mr. Harrison will not aid or assist in the solicitation of campaign donations, nor will he accept any campaign donations on behalf of any other person; and
 - d. Mr. Harrison will not aid or assist in the expenditure(s) of campaign proceeds.
